MAINTENANCE MECHANIC APPRENTICE

Are you looking to gain new skills and start a career? Waukesha Foundry, Inc. is currently looking for a Maintenance Mechanic Apprentice to join our team. This position will provide excellent on-the-job and formal education to learn our business, learn essential skills to be a skilled Maintenance Mechanic and prepare for future opportunities within our expanding company.

Maintenance mechanics, install, dismantle, or move machinery and heavy equipment according to layout plans, blueprints, or other drawings. They keep machines, mechanical equipment or the structure of an establishment in repair. Troubleshoot and repair equipment and machinery malfunctions. They assemble, install and set equipment such as shafting, motors, generators, air compressors and conveyors using hand and power tools. They align machines and equipment using manual hoists, jacks, and hand tools. Duties may involve pipefitting, insulating, welding, machining, carpentry, repairing electrical or mechanical equipment, installing, aligning and balancing new equipment, and repairing buildings, floors and stairs. Hydraulic installation, repair and troubleshooting. The maintenance mechanic apprentice will work in a factory setting both inside or outside in all weather conditions. They must work at heights, in awkward positions, and in confined spaces.

The term of the apprenticeship shall be 8,320 hours and is a four year training program. The Apprentice shall attend the assigned Wisconsin Technical College System for paid related instruction eight hours per week and satisfactorily complete the prescribed course material for a minimum of 576 hours. On- the- job experience as well as formal instruction will provide training in machine and equipment maintenance, repair and operation, machine and equipment installation, hydraulics/pneumatics, metallurgy, preventative inspection, safety, and optional work processes. Apprentice must complete Red Cross First Aid, CPR, and Transition-To-Trainer Courses.

Applicants must be at least 18 years of age and have a High School Diploma or equivalent.
