Job Description

- Must be able to read masters
- Must be able to tell the difference between washes
- Must know how to prep and paint molds
- Must know how to operate hoist
- Must know how to cover, seal, and place pouring boxes on molds.
- Must know how to make steel shot
- Must know how to cut gating systems
- Maintain proper housekeeping for work area
- Other duties as assigned by supervisor
- Must be able to perform the above in a safe manner and as part of the team
- Must be able to tell the difference between sands
- Must be able to set chills, risers, sand in the correct spot
- Must make good molds.
- Must be able to draw molds properly.
- Must know how to make good pepset cores.

Requirements

Education: High school diploma, GED, or equivalent.

Skills: Must have the ability to use direct reading and fixed gauges. Requires use of basic arithmetic functions such as add, subtract, multiply, divide, and work with percentages and decimals. Must be able to read and understand shop paperwork.
